Primary Descending Chart

The charts begin here. From this page to the end of the book, all you will find are charts. Charts with names, birth years and death years. Charts with photos and brief descriptions of those photos. The charts on pages 46 through 66 deal entirely with the children of Joseph A. and Margaret Studer. Each of their charts has a left hand opposing page which has additional photos and a story. The story is either written by the individual named on the chart or by another family member.

How to use the charts. Well, first take notice of the names indicated at the top of the chart, these names will tell you who the chart is representing. Next take notice of the grayed boxes, and the directional arrows. These two elements will guide you through the chart, leading you to the appropriate person or persons. Jacob Studer was born in 1602, Rimbach, Alsace, France. His wife was Anna (Lautenschlager) Studer. He died in 1678 in Rimbach, Alsace, France.

Nicolaus Studer was born in 1650, Rimbach, Alsace, France. His wife was Anna (Zimmerman) Studer. He died in 1690 in Rimbach, Alsace, France.

Johannes Jacob Studer was born in 1683, Rimbach, Alsace, France. His wife was Marie Agatha (Behra) Studer. He died in 1731 in Rimbach, Alsace, France.

Johannes Petrus Studer was born in 1715, Ermensbach, Alsace, France. His wife was Maria Catharina (Weis) Studer. He died in 1791 in Ermensbach, Alsace, France.

Johannes Antonius Studer was born in 1743, Oberbruck, Alsace, France. His wife was Maria Anna (Negelin) Studer. He died in 1800 in Oberbruck, Alsace, France.

Sebastian Studer, was born in 1776 Oberbruck, Alsace, France. His first wife was Anna Maria Ringenbach. His second wife was Anna Marie (Fritz) Studer. He died in 1841 in France.

Oh yes. You'll need to know that I've designed the charts with overlapping information. This information starts at the box about Sebastian and Anna Marie. It continues with the row about Amandus and Francisca. Then the final overlap is the row of names which are the children of Amandus and Francisca.

Each chart which has the overlapping information, is the chart which starts a new family section. All the charts are organized according to birth order. The only exception is the William and Matilda chart which is combined with the Key Code. Matilda is out of birth order.


Refer to the Key Code. It will give you a more indepth understanding of the charts. It indicates the information about adoption, divorce, first, second, third marriages, etc.

It didn't seem necessary to add pages for children who had limited history.






Notice that the charts on subsequent pages are filled with photos of family members other than those indicated by name on the charts. This was done to utilized the space.

The photo to the left shows the three children of Edward and Clara Studer. Wilbur is in the back behind Maurice (to the left) and Vernon (to the right).







The children of William and Laura Studer










